Commenced Beginning northwest seventeen rods & twenty
links from the northerly corner of sixty one acres laid
out to the Ministry of the first Parish in Talmouth,
thence northwest one hundred and seventy two rods and
five links to a stake, thence south twenty two degrees
a half west forty seven rods, thence southeast one
