KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That
Me Joseph Pride, Gentleman and William Pride *Woman*
 both of *Tahmorth in the County of Cumberland* - - -

in consideration of the sum of one thousand Dollars - - -

paid us by *William Pride* *Jnr.* of said *Tahmorth*
Woman

the receipt whereof *Me* do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give,
 grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said *William Pride*
Jnr. his - - - heirs and assigns forever

forty acres of land lying on the northerly side of *Pegmup*
Scot River in said *Tahmorth, Concorda* as follows,
 viz. beginning at the northwesterly corner of sixty acres of
 land laid out to *Benuger Cobb*, thence running
 northwesterly adjoining land of *Stops Austin* one
 hundred and sixty rods to a stake, and from thence
 two corners extending northwesterly bounding south-
 erly on land of *John Proctor* & northerly on land of *John Blake* till
 forty acres are completed. Being forty acres off of the westerly
 side of the one hundred & four acre lot laid out by the *Pro-*
Prictors of Tahmorth to our honored father *Joseph Pride*
 late of said *Tahmorth* deceased. -

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the afore-granted and bargained
 premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof to the said
William Pride *Jnr.* his
 heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever.

And *Me* do covenant with the said *William Pride*
Jnr. his heirs and assigns, that *Me* are lawfully seized
 in fee of the premises; that they are free of all incumbrances;
 that *Me* have good right to sell and convey the same to the said
William Pride *Jnr.* to hold as aforesaid.

And that *Me* will warrant and defend the same to the said
William Pride *Jnr.* his
 heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims and demands
 of all persons.

have hereunto set our hands and seals this *fourth* day of
December - in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and two.
