ural lives the remainder to myself my heirs and assigns
And I do covenant with the said Joseph and Hannah and
their assigns that I have good right to sell and convey the same
premises to them to hold as aforesaid and will warrant
the same to them during the term aforesaid they surrendering
and paying unto me my heirs or assigns one Dollar a year
for each and every year during said term as rent for the prem-
