KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT

John Brackett of Talmouth, in the County of Cumberland and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Gentleman

in consideration of the sum of twenty Dollars

paid me by Henry Ride of Talmouth, in the County of Cumberland aforesaid, Yeoman

the receipt whereof do hereby acknowledge—do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said

Henry Ride his heirs and assigns for ever

A lot of land lying and being in the Township of Talmouth aforesaid, bounded, Beginning at the most Southwesterly corner of my land purchased of Joseph Ride, running North thirty two degrees East, sixty rods, thence North fifty one degrees East, sixty eight rods, thence South forty five degrees East, sixty nine rods and one half a rod to the first bound, containing one acre and eighty one rods

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforegranted and bargained premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof, to the said Henry Ride his John Brackett, my self, my heirs, Executors and Administrators heirs and assigns, to his heirs use and behoof for ever. And I the said do covenant with the said Henry Ride his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises; that they are free of all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Henry Ride to hold as aforesaid. And that I will warrant and defend the same to the said Henry Ride his heirs and assigns for ever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
