 unto the said *Samuel Ride and his*.

heirs and assigns forever a lot of land in said *Westbrook* bounded as
 follows *Begining* at a stake in the corner made by the
Northwesterly side of a town road *and* the *westerly* side of *Nathan*
Rides land where he now dwells thence running north thirty
 four degrees west twenty two rods thence Southwest eleven rods
 thence South thirty four degrees East twenty two rods to
 a road thence by the road to the first bounds containing one
 acre *and* eighty two rods more or less

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the aforegranted and bargained premises, with all the
 privileges and appertinances thereof, to the said *Samuel Ride and his*
 heirs and assigns, to *his* *and* their use and behoof forever—
 And *I* do covenant with the said *Samuel and his*
 heirs and assigns, that *I am* lawfully seized in fee of the premises; that they are
 free of all incumbrances; that *I* have good right to sell and convey the same to the said
Samuel to hold as aforesaid. And that *I*
 and *his* heirs shall and will warrant and defend the same to the said *Samuel and*
his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
