To have and to hold the aforesaid and bargained premises with all the privileges & appurtenances thereof to the said grantees and their heirs to them and their use & behoof forever And I do covenant with the said grantees & their heirs that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises that they are free from all incumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said grantees to hold as aforesaid And that I will and my heirs shall warrant & defend the same to the said grantees & their heirs forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons
