KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I Samuel Pride of Westbrook but resident of Portland both in the County of Cumberland and State of Maine. Trader.
 in consideration of the sum of *five hundred dollars*
 paid by

Peter Pride of said Westbrook Gentleman

the receipt whereof *I* do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said

Peter Pride his

heirs and assigns forever, a certain lot of land lying in said Westbrook bounded as follows to wit beginning at a stake standing on the northwesterly side of the road leading from *Francis Prides* to *Saccarappa* and on the northeasterly side of *Nathan Prides* land thence running North thirty four degrees west fifty rods thence north forty one degrees east nine rods thence Northwest twenty four rods thence Northeast thirty rods adjoining said *Nathan's* land thence ^{South} thirty three degrees thirty minutes east seventy rods thence south forty one degrees west thirty six and a half rods to the first bounds containing sixteen acres and recorded in the Cumberland Registry Book 30 page 160

And also one other lot lying in said Westbrook bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a stake standing in the corner made by the northerly side line of the road leading to *Saccarappa* and the westerly side of *Nathan Prides* land where he now dwells thence running from said stake North thirty four degrees west twenty two rods thence ^{South} eleven rods thence South thirty four degrees east twenty two rods to said road thence by the road to the first bounds mentioned containing one acre and eighty two rods more or less

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforegranted and bargained premises, with all the privileges and appertinances thereof, to the said *Peter Pride his*

heirs and assigns, to their use and behoof forever. And *I* do covenant with the said *Peter his* heirs and assigns, that *I am* lawfully seized in fee of the premises; that they are free of all incumbrances; that *I* have good right to sell and convey the same to the said *Peter* to hold as aforesaid; and that *I* and my heirs shall and will warrant and defend the same to the said *Peter Pride his* heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
