convey, and forever quitclaim unto the said James Gowen his

heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest in and to a certain lot of land
situated in said Westbrook on the west side of the duck pond
brook near the Mill containing five acres and Eighty six square
rods and is the same which I purchased of Ebenzer L. Roberts as
by his deed to me dated January 5th 1829 may appear and
the same is subject to a mortgage to said Roberts

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all the priv-
ileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, to ~~him~~ the said James his
heirs and assigns, forever. And

I do covenant with the said James his
heirs and assigns, that I will warrant and forever defend the premises to
the said James his
heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands
of all persons claiming by, through, or under me.
